



Before painting, resin parts should be washed with liquid soap and water to remove any mold release. This kit should be assembled with CA super glue. Changing conditions during shipping may cause some flat parts to warp slightly. Pieces can be gently bent back into shape, or softened slightly with warm water for reshaping.

Resin dust can be harmful! Wear a dust mask and work in a ventilated area when sanding or filing resin.

Not a toy! This kit is intended for the mature hobbyist. Contains small parts. Keep away from children.

- 1) Carefully trim or file any excess resin from the back edges of the walls & bottom of the roof
- 2) Choose the base or surface where you want to place your building. Using a ruler, draw out a square (or rectangle for Small buildings) with sides as long as each wall piece



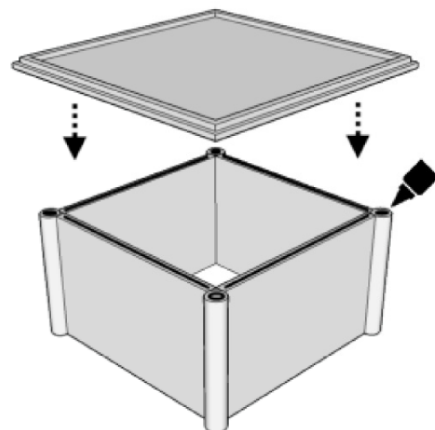
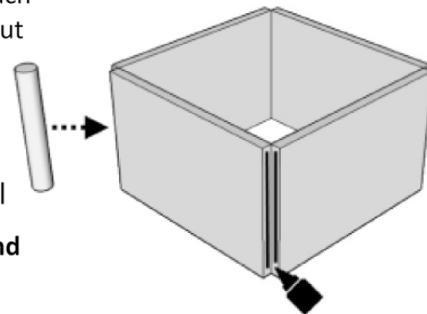
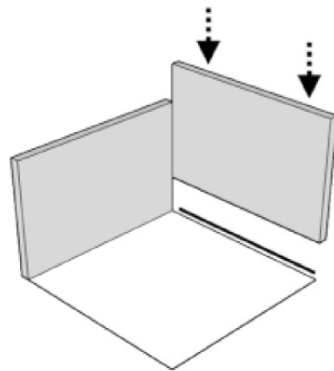
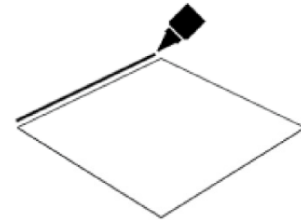
To build without a base, assemble on a thin piece of plasticard. Use only a couple drops of glue to attach each wall. Once completed, the building can be cut or snapped off the plasticard base.

- 3) Glue each wall section to the base, with the back edge along one side of the marked square. Test each piece and adjust so that all walls are even and vertical



When adding an Upper Level kit, glue the top and bottom section of each wall together before beginning assembly

- 4) In the corners, run a bead of glue along the edge of each wall. Place columns into each corner space where the walls meet.
- 5) Corner columns may be slightly too long – trim or file the tops of the columns so they are square and even with the top of the walls
- 6) Run a bead of glue along the top of the walls and corner columns. Carefully center the roof over the building and glue in place.
